

It was decided that Capacity building programme including sessions on life skills, soft skills, and communication skills to be started with immediate effect. Departments should organize classes in association with the Career Guidance Cell. Remedial classes should be made mandatory by identifying the weaker students.
2.	Hostel facility unavailable for girl students	Parents	As the number of girl students are comparatively more than boys, it was decided at the council and discussed with the PTA members and advised the Principal to forward a request to the DC to allow accommodation of girls in the boys' hostel temporarily.
3.	Students do not get enough opportunities regarding campus placements	Parents	The matter was discussed at the PTA meeting and was decided to make maximum use of the alumni network to attract more companies and banks for recruitment. Also to engage training sessions for students on how to prepare CV/Résumé and to prepare them for job interviews.
4.	Contribution of alumni in campus placements	Alumni	Alumni Secretary offered wholehearted support in promoting career placement activities for the students. Alumni representatives from each department were asked to prepare a list of potential alumni to continue interaction and plan future placement procedures.

For the time being as remedial measure, an alternate arrangement to share the work allotment was suggested. (to be done by the Head of the departments).
