

DETAILED REPORT







The Edward Said Memorial Lecture Series has inspired by a peak of research interest in Said and his theoretical contributions. As part of the same, the Department of Functional English, EKNM Govt. College, Elerithattu organised this lecture on Nationalism and Gender with 63 attendees. It aimed to equip undergraduate students with the foundational knowledge on Edward Said, the theorist and while engaging skills necessary to embark on their research journey effectively.


This lecture provided a platform for students to engage in a critical examination of the intersections between nationalism, gender, and the enduring legacy of Edward Said. Held against the backdrop of contemporary global challenges, this lecture aimed to foster dialogue and understanding around complex issues of identity, power, and resistance.

Dr. Saji Mathew began with exploring the legacy of Edward Said's groundbreaking work, particularly his seminal text "Orientalism," and how it continues to shape critical discourse across multiple fields, including postcolonial studies, cultural theory, and identity politics. Being a scholar in Cultural Studies and Postcolonialism, Dr. Saji Mathew could engage students on how nationalism, as both an ideology and a political project, often relies on gendered narratives and symbols to construct and legitimize national identities. He also explored how nationalist movements both exploit and challenge gendered hierarchies, impacting the experiences of women, LGBTQ+ individuals, and other marginalized groups.

Key Themes and Insights: Throughout the lecture, several key themes and insights emerged:

- Power Dynamics: Discussions with students highlighted the ways in which
 nationalism intersects with patriarchal structures, reinforcing inequalities and
 exclusions based on gender, race, and class. Participants learned to critically examine
 how power operates within nationalist discourses, shaping notions of identity,
 citizenship, and belonging.
- Agency and Resistance: His presentation underscored the agency and resistance of
 individuals and communities within nationalist contexts. From women's movements
 challenging patriarchal nationalism to LGBTQ+ activists advocating for inclusive
 national identities, he highlighted strategies of resistance and resilience that contest
 dominant narratives and foster social change.
- Transnational Solidarities: He further emphasized the importance of forging transnational solidarities and alliances in the struggle against nationalist and patriarchal systems of oppression.
- The possibilities of research in the subject area had also been taken up for discussion at the end of the session.

To conclude, the lecture on "Nationalism and Gender" provided a thought-provoking space for dialogue and reflection on pressing issues of our time. By critically engaging with the intersections of nationalism, gender, and the legacy of Edward Said, participants deepened their understanding of power dynamics, agency, and resistance in the struggle for social justice and equity. Moving forward, the lecture highlighted the importance of continued dialogue, activism, and scholarship in challenging dominant narratives and creating more inclusive, equitable societies for all.



Name of the workshop/ seminar/ conference: Post-Gender as part of the Edward Said Memorial Lecture Series





The lecture on 18th February 2020 with 43 attendees under the guidance of Resource Person Dr. Latha E.S, sought to examine the evolving contours of post-theory within the context of Edward Said's enduring legacy. Against the backdrop of shifting intellectual paradigms and socio-political landscapes, this lecture aimed to interrogate the intersections between post-theory, cultural critique, and Saidian thought.

Dr. Latha has been an eclectic persona in the academic sphere dabbling in the interdisciplinary elements of Cultural studies and Post-theory. Her takes on the origins of the same have been considered one of the critical points of thought in the academic discourse.

She began with the telling of how Edward Said's seminal works, notably
"Orientalism" and "Culture and Imperialism," exerted a profound influence on posttheoretical discourses, particularly within the fields of postcolonial studies and
cultural critique. Said's emphasis on the politics of representation, the construction of
Otherness, and the intertwining of knowledge and power resonates deeply with posttheoretical sensibilities, shaping how scholars approach texts, cultures, and identities.

The Lecture was a detailed one with two sessions of 2 hrs each in the morning and afternoon respectively.

Dr Latha hence followed the origins with certain key ideas that brought about discussions on research interest as well.

She charted the themes of ,

- Situated Knowledges: Dr Latha underscored the importance of situated knowledges
 in post-theoretical approaches, highlighting the significance of context, positionality, and
 lived experiences in shaping interpretations and analyses. By centering marginalized voices
 and perspectives, she elaborated on how post-theory disrupted dominant narratives and opens
 up space for alternative epistemologies.
- 2. Hybridity and Fluidity: She conveyed with examples as how post-theoretical approaches embrace hybridity and fluidity, rejecting essentialist understandings of identity and culture. Students learned how Said's notion of "contrapuntal reading" informs postcolonial methodologies, allowing for complex engagements with hybrid, intercultural texts and contexts.
- 3. Global Perspectives: The lecture emphasized the global reach and relevance of post-theoretical discourses, transcending disciplinary boundaries and geographical borders. Students understood the need for transnational dialogues and collaborations that address the interconnected challenges of colonialism, imperialism, and globalization.

Thus, the lecture on "Post-Theory" provided a dynamic forum for engagement with pressing questions at the intersection of theory, culture, and politics.





The Indian context was discussed, emphasizing the need for adaptive strategies.

Conclusion

The seminar highlighted the urgency of addressing climate change and the importance of collaborative efforts to mitigate its impact. As we face a changing climate, informed discussions and proactive measures are crucial.




