Report on the Seminar on 'Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights' On 22 March 2023

On 22/03/2023, the Department of Political Science at E.K.N.M Government College, Elerithattu, organised an enlightening seminar on the theme "Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights" (IPR). This seminar aimed to provide an in-depth understanding of the various aspects of intellectual property rights and their significance in the modern world. The event witnessed participation from students, faculty members, and distinguished guests.

The seminar commenced with the opening notes by Dr. Narayanan P, faculty member of the Department of Economics, K.M.M. Government Women's College, Kannur, who chaired the session. Dr. Narayanan highlighted the importance of understanding intellectual property rights in today's knowledge-driven economy and emphasised the role of such seminars in enhancing the academic and practical knowledge of the students.

Following the welcome address, the Principal-in-charge, Dr. K.A. Johnson, delivered the presidential address. Dr. Johnson expressed his appreciation for organising the seminar on such a pertinent topic and underscored the college's commitment to fostering a culture of intellectual curiosity and legal awareness among its students. He elaborated on the critical role of intellectual property rights in promoting innovation, creativity, and economic development.

The keynote address was delivered by Ms. Jilu Lisbath George, a distinguished research scholar from the Central University of Kerala. Ms Jilu Lisbath George, provided a comprehensive introduction to intellectual property rights, covering various essential aspects such as the definition and types of intellectual property rights (including patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets), the importance of intellectual property rights in encouraging innovation and creativity, promoting economic growth and development, and protecting consumer interests. She also discussed the legal framework and international treaties relevant to IPR, including an overview of national and international IPR laws, the role of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), and key international agreements such as the TRIPS Agreement.

The resource person addressed challenges and issues in intellectual property rights, including piracy and counterfeiting, enforcement of IPR, and balancing public interest and private rights. He supplemented his presentation with case studies and real-world applications, showcasing examples of successful intellectual property management and the impact of IPR on various industries such as pharmaceuticals, technology, and entertainment.

Following the keynote address, an interactive session was held, allowing participants to ask questions and engage in discussions. This segment facilitated a deeper understanding of the practical implications of intellectual property rights and provided valuable insights into current challenges and future trends in the field.


