



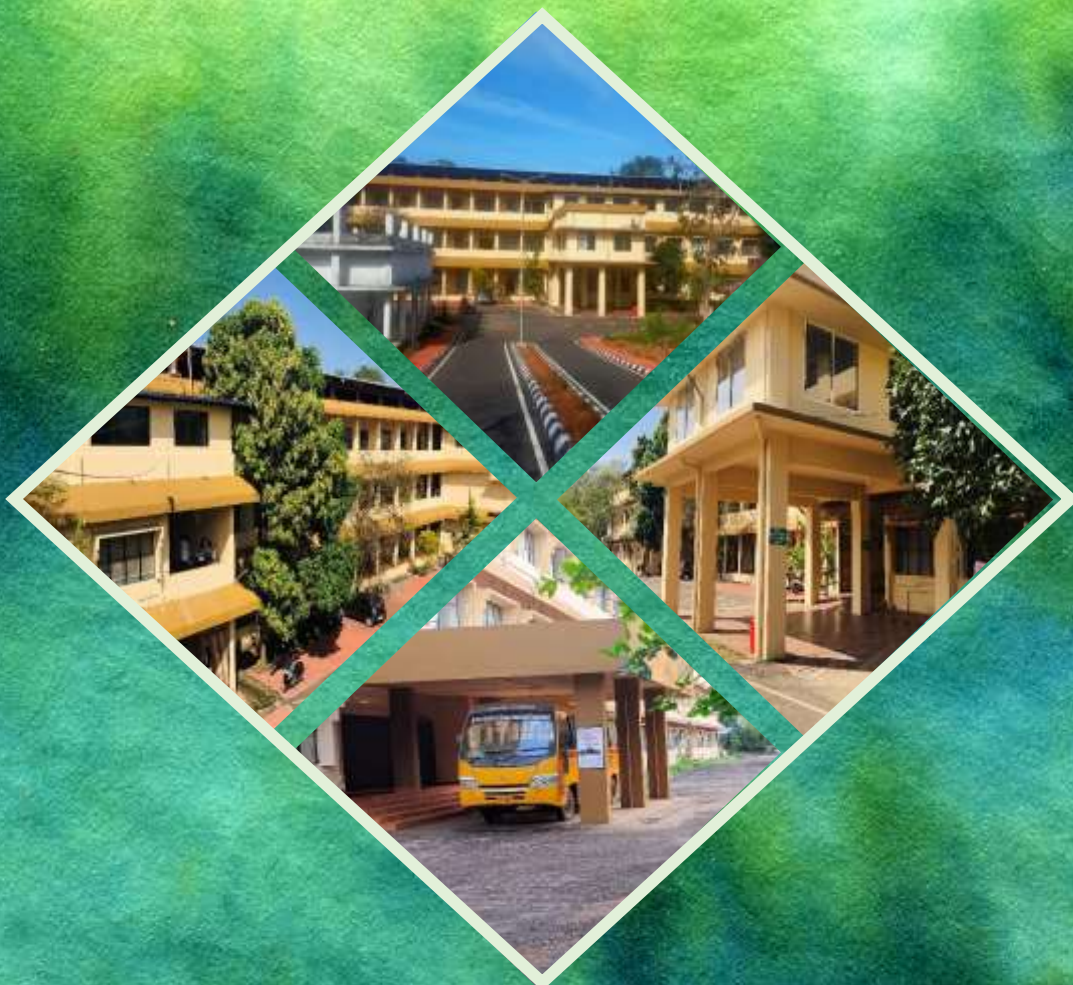

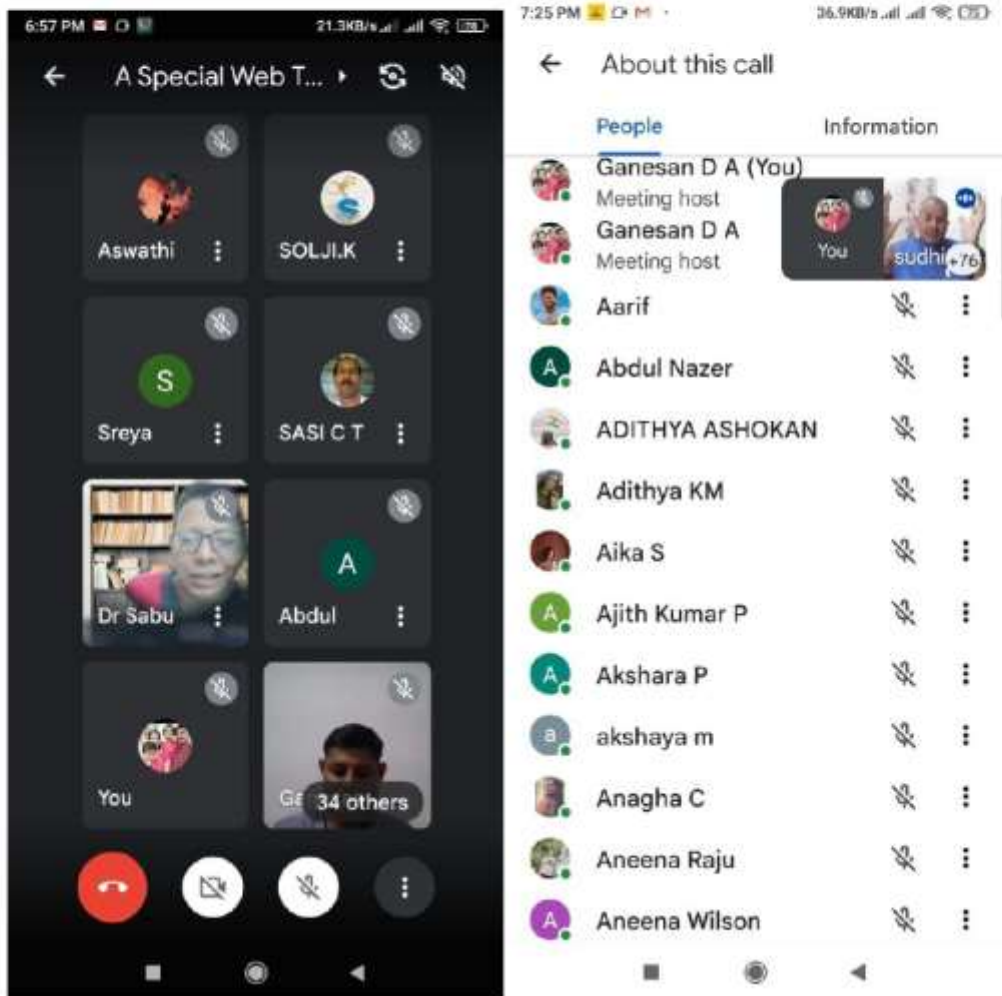

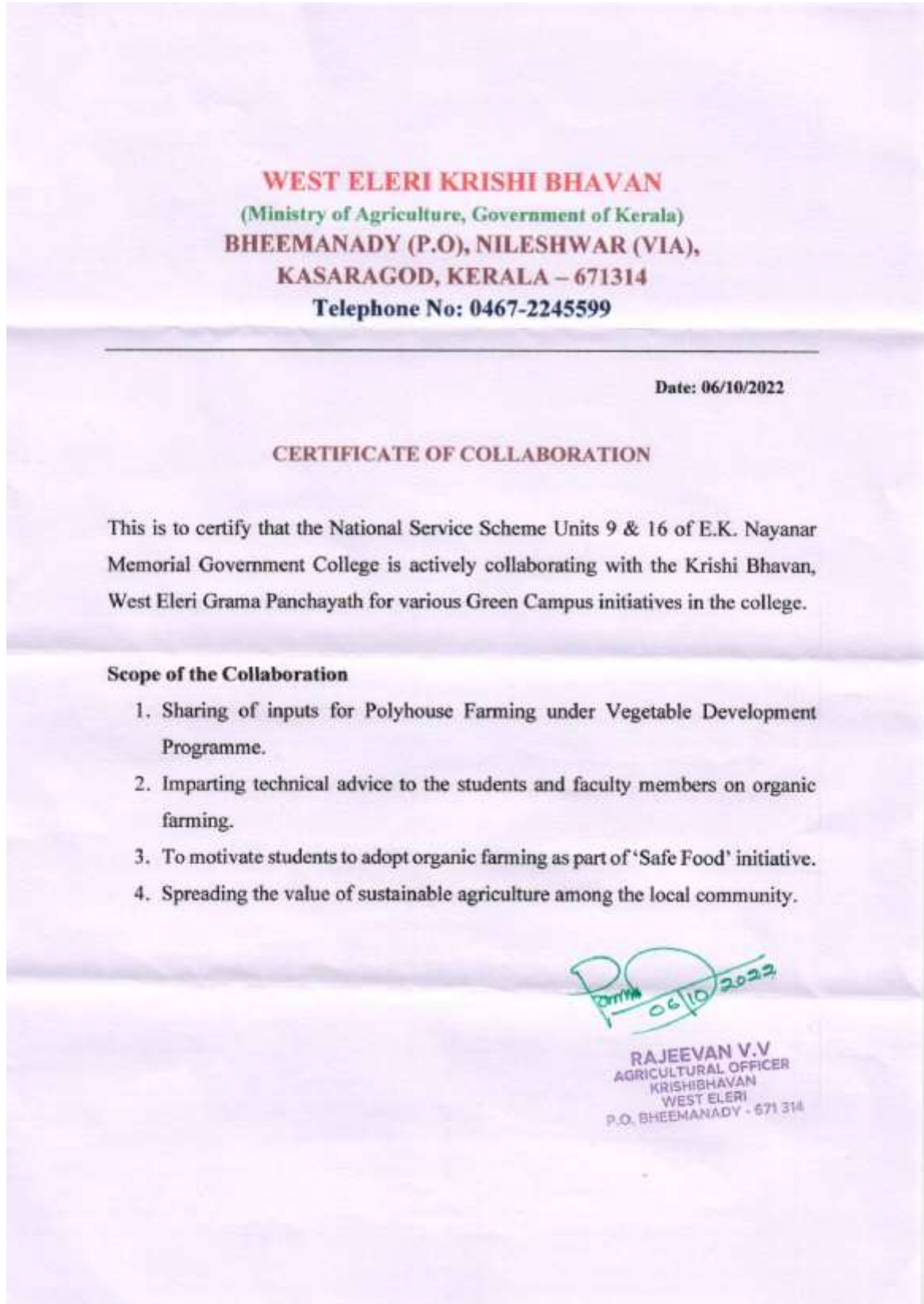

Under the collaborative platform formed between the IQACs of E.K. Nayanar Memorial Government College, Elerithattu and Nirmalagiri College, Kuthuparamba, an invited talk on 'Institutional Quality Assurance' was organised on 23/08/2022. Dr. Sabu Sebastian, IQAC Co-ordinator, Nirmalagiri College was the resource person. Dr. Sabu, an esteemed expert in the field of quality assurance, was the keynote speaker for the event. With his vast experience and knowledge, Dr. Sabu shed light on various aspects related to quality assurance in educational institutions.

The programme began with the opening note of Dr. Solji K Thomas, Principal of E.K. Nayanar Memorial Government College, Elerithattu. He stressed the need for focussing on institutional quality for serving the vision and mission of the college.

- Importance of quality assurance in higher education
- Strategies for implementing quality assurance measures
- Role of stakeholders in maintaining institutional quality
- Aligning quality assurance with academic goals and objectives
- Continuous improvement and feedback mechanisms

Dr. Sabu started his session by describing institutional quality in the context of a higher education institution. 



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

INVITED LECTURE ON 'RESEARCH METHODOLOGY FOR
SOCIAL SURVEY STUDIES'

On January 17, 2023, the Department of Economics at E.K.N.M. Government College, Elerithattu, in collaboration with its counterpart at Rajapuram College, hosted an enlightening invited lecture on 'Research Methodology for Social Survey Studies.' The lecture was delivered by Dr. Joby Thomas, an Assistant Professor of Economics at Rajapuram College, who is well-versed in the nuances of research methodologies within the social sciences.
