

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NAAC Peer Team Recommendations during the First Cycle Accreditation 2018

As per the recommendations provided by the NAAC peer team for the first cycle, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell under the guidance of honorable principal decided to plan for the next cycle. It was decided to cover all the suggestions and make necessary changes in order to improve the institutional teaching learning process, research and provide service to the society. Following are the recommendations by the peer team for Quality Enhancement of the Institution for the second cycle:

Major Recommendations: -

- Value added/enrichment programmes need to be started.
- Science stream to be strengthened with more courses.
- Faculty research activities need to be strengthened.
- Collaborations for academic enhancement and research activities may be initiated.
- Need to establish INFLIBNET/DELNET/IUC or any such facility for e-book resources.
- Vacant posts need to be urgently filled, particularly in the department of Physics.
- Introduce Soft Skills and job-oriented programmes for student employments.
- New programme in M. Com needs to be started.
- Girls Hostel of higher capacity need to be constructed, being remote area.
- Hostel superintendent, cook and permanent staff be appointed.
- Modern playground be constructed. Indoor stadium is also required.
- Existing Science Block be expanded vertically and horizontally.
- College is to arrange transportation facilities.
- NSS has to adopt nearby village for extension of social service.



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Major Accomplishments 2018-2023

- Value added/enrichment courses implemented by all the departments.
- O 7 Faculty members completed Ph.D. Of this, 3 faculty members under the UGC-Faculty Development Programme.
- Collaborations for academic enhancement and research activities initiated.
- INFLIBNET facility was established.
- Vacant posts were filled either through permanent appointments or through ad-hoc appointments.
- Soft Skills and job-oriented programmes for student employments were organised.
- o The state government of Kerala has approved M.Com programme in principle and final sanction is to be received.
- Girls Hostel of higher capacity expanded to 120 students.
- Hostel superintendent, cook and other staff were appointed for one-year contract and regular renewal of the same was made.
- New academic blocks for Economics and Commerce are near completion.
- Public transport system to the college has been improved through the efforts made by PTA and other functionaries.
- NSS adopted nearby village for extension of social service.
- New programme in B.A. Political Science was started in 2020.
