On the 5th of January 2023, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of EKNM Government College, Elerithattu, successfully organized a Talk to an Expert session on the National Education Policy (NEP). The event aimed to provide a comprehensive understanding of the NEP's objectives, implications, and its role in shaping the future of education in India. The esteemed speaker for the session was Dr. Vipinchandran K P, an Assistant Professor of Economics at K.M.M. Government Women's College.

The attendees raised pertinent questions regarding the practical implications of the NEP, its alignment with global educational standards, and the timeline for its implementation. Dr. Vipinchandran responded to each query with insightful answers, providing clarity and encouraging a positive outlook towards the changes proposed by the NEP.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks, acknowledging the valuable contribution of Dr. Vipinchandran and the active participation of the audience. The IQAC expressed its commitment to organizing more such sessions to foster a culture of continuous learning and improvement within the college.
