



GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

The campus abides by the Green Charter of the Kannur University and has taken its case of Green Campus initiative seriously through the measures mentioned below. This includes setting up awareness posters in place and educating the students about the need to maintain Greenery in the premises for a sustainable campus life. Sustainability pledges and awareness camps have consistently been held across years with the support from the Department of Forestry, Government of Kerala. A Seminar on Global Warming and Climate Change has been conducted by the Department of Physics, sponsored by the PTA on 20/11/2019. The practice of Farming has been incorporated in hostels, bringing up a generation of students to appreciate seasonal produce. The institution has a Bio-park where the students are offered a place to become one with nature.

The NSS as an organised system of community service has also made sure that initiatives like Organic Farming has been taught to students which would enable them to share the sustainability practices with the community. Trees beneficial to the landscape have been planted by the students under the aegis of the NSS. In addition, a polyhouse has been placed on the rooftop of the canteen to teach the students on self-sufficiency and food security.



CLEAN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

At EKNM, in alignment with Kannur university's green charter policy, we have regular cleaning schedules in all campus areas. A strategic collection of waste is engaged through separate bins on all floors and administrative rooms. Daily management of waste is conducted by designated sanitation workers. The disposal of waste is carried out consistently through channels of Haritha Karma Sena as a part of Kerala's policy on waste management system; and locally disposed with the assistance of Grama Panchayat's Mini Material Collection Facility. Bio-waste is also managed sustainably by directing the same to a local Pig-farm. Plastic bottle collection grid has been placed near the library to encourage effective disposal of plastic. Daily eco- friendly measures like usage of paper glass, steel glass and utensils in the canteen and the hostels. Students are encouraged to switch off fans and lights as part of practice. Energy efficient gadgets have been installed in the campus.

E waste management: The institution attempts to minimise the e-waste by means of power and data cables and with long term durability of the same. It segregates the e-waste into chemical, plastic and recyclable materials and a separate storage facility is provided.


